workshops, face-to-face meetings and personalised feedback, this programme gives you the possibility of creating a strong network and integrating sustainable strategies in your artistic practice.

The Summer Training for Emerging Artists, developed by The Artist and the Others, provides concrete knowledge, essential skills, and reallife connections in order for you to extend your network. It is a unique opportunity to build a professional backbone which can support a career in the arts.

*Full and partial scholarships available for artists based in Munich, while international artists can apply to mobility funds. Recently graduated artists, and those who are at the beginning of their artistic career, can easily fall into a so-called "black hole". It is a precarious period, leading 90% of graduated artists to abandon their artistic careers.

LET'S ADDRESS THE PROBLEM

The cause is a lack of knowledge about the dynamics of the art world, practical skills and professional connections. This training programme offers artists an extensive range of tools, concrete knowledge, essential skills & real-life networking opportunities, increasing confidence by building a strong professional backbone for a sustainable, long-lasting career in the arts.

WHAT DOES THIS PROGRAMME COVER?

WHAT DOES IT INCLUDE?

The 2024, newly updated 5th edition of the training programme includes more than 24 hours of professional hands-on workshops, presentations, discussions, visits to cultural spaces & interactive activities.

Each participant will receive a **toolkit** in advance, including a detailed description of the content of the programme, relevant information and useful links, which can be used and referred back to at any stage of their careers.

CENTRAL TOPICS COVERED:

- → How to navigate the artworld(s).
- → How to develop a sustainable practice (meet galleries, off spaces, curators and other artists).
- → How to select residency, exhibitions and grant applications, for emerging artists and artistparents
- → Building a meaningful portfolio & clear artist statement.
- → How to introduce **Care** in your practice and projects.



This training programme has been tailored considering artists' need for a supportive professional backbone of knowledge, skills and connections.

WHAT IS THE FOCUS?

This Summer Training specifically addresses the obstacles that artists face at the start of their careers.

AS A PARTICIPATING ARTIST YOU WILL GET:

- → Tailored feedback, based on your artistic practice;
- → Face to face meetings with gallerists, curators and art workers with many years of experience in the different art worlds;
- → Personalised feedback on your artist statement and artist residency applications;
- → Live meetings with local & international professionals from the field.
- → Presentation of final, revised portfolio in-person, at Lothringer 13 in Munich, and online, on the 11th of October 2024. Different experts, gallerists, curators and art workers, are invited to this **PORTFOLIO REVIEW SESSION**, and participants will receive individual feedback and advice on their own portfolio.

→ Once completed, participants have 2 extra hours of INDIVIDUAL COACHING (to be used in the 12 months completing the Training) which can support you in further developing your artistic career.

WHAT DOES THE SUMMER TRAINING OFFER THAT OTHER COURSES DO NOT?

All of the trainings included are tailored to each artist's practice.

The programme provides real-life connections and highly interactive activities. You will have the chance to participate actively, ask experts questions, receive answers & engage with other artists and professionals. You will extend your knwoledge & skills on how to navigate the artworld and build a sustainable practice.

Held in Munich, at Lothringer 13 and PLATFORM, it is an exceptional programme which continues to provide unique and extremely beneficial experiences to all participating artists.

- → Gain new professional knowledge and skills in the art field and its intersections:

- → Explore and get to know the international and local art scene in

Munich;

- → Connect with curators and gallerists;
- → Incorporate CARE within your artist practice & in your projects.
- → Become inspired by Munich's cultural scene, and meet other artists from all around the world.

You will leave with new and updated professional knowledge, practical skills, a greatly expanded professional network, an action plan for the next steps in your professional life and long-lasting connections to inspiring artists from around the world!







DAY 1

THE ARTIST AS A PROFESSIONAL: HOW DO YOU PRESENT YOUR WORK AND YOUR PRACTICE?

After a short introduction, we will work **on presentation skills, getting to know each other's practice**, guiding you in the **creation of a clear artist's statement** in a workshop by **Jessica Capra** (Curator, Director & Head of Projects - The Artist and the Others) and **Mariana Sesma** (Curator, Artist & Cultural Manager).

In the afternoon, there will be an interactive workshop by PhD. **Emilia Telese**, Artist & Lecturer, addressing the **relationships between artists**, **society**, **markets and the world economy**. It will also target **how to create a self-employed practice**, **managing insecurity**, **and minimising the risks**.

Emilia Telese has extensive knowledge on the artworld, experience working individually and with institutions and has researched the social value and the individualisation of artist.

WORKSHOP ON ARTIST STATEMENTS AND PRESENTATION SKILLS BY JESSICA CAPRA & MARIANA SESMA

How to write a clear and effective artist statement & how to create a powerful personal presentation.

We will also look at presentation techniques, key tools and skills that you can use when talking about and presenting your practice.

Being an Artist, as a Profession: How to navigate the artworld & create a sustainable workflow of projects.

- → How does the art world work, and what is the relationship between artists, their ideas and their representation in the world's art stage?
- \rightarrow Can you live on art alone?
- → How can artists create a sustainable, independent career?
- → How can one create a workflow of funded projects to generate a living?
- →How to deal with institutions and collaborators;
- → How to calculate your rate of pay and practice sustainability;
- → How to develop a sustainable art practice.

DAY 2

CARE + POST PRECARITY: FAIR PRACTICE AND HOW TO SURVIVE AS AN ARTIST

In the morning, representatives of **Platform BK**, Dutch institution researching the role of art in society and taking action for better policies, will lead a workshop looking at the possibilities of **Fair Art Practice**. More specifically, this workshop will breakdown the **guidelines they have developed**, **looking at the artists' rights** and what a fair fee is. We will also look at the possibilities of Fair Art Practice and artists receiving a stable income for their work.

In the afternoon, Artist, Writer, and Researcher Magdalena Kallenberger will address the topic of Care in the Arts, tackling the invisibility-visibility of care, and Art work, with a focus on motherhood.

Magdalena Kallenberger uses video, photography, performance, installation, and text, combining research into feminist histories and writing with autobiography, theory, and performative elements in her artistic practice. Kallenberger's research-based, and often collaborative practice, investigates themes around radical care and feminist practices. She is also one of the founders of the artist collective Maternal Fantasies.

In this interactive workshop, Magdalena Kallenberger will also provide examples of best practices and share her personal expeirences from working in the art world.

DAY 3

YOUR NEXT STEPS: PORTFOLIOS, ARTIST RESIDENCIES AND NETWORKING EVENT

The final day of the training programme will include a a **portfolio workshop** looking at: **theory**, **practice**, **and critique** with guest speakers: **Lisa Britzger** (Independet Curator - Lothringer 13), **Heike Dempster** (Curator & Artist Manager), and **Mariana Sesma** (Curator & Jury Member). **On the 11th of October** at **Lothringer 13 Halle - Munich**, you will be invited to an **extra portfolio review session**. Here you will present your reviewed portfolio to **pivotal stakeholders**, **curators and gallery owners**, uniquely selected in relation to participants' focus.

In the afternoon, there will be a workshop on **Artist Residencies** by **The Artist** and the Others, in which we will look at artist residencies through a critical lens, touching on how they can be a tool, the opportunities which exist, and how to navigate the options, funding and more. This will be followed by an **interactive** discussion on your next career steps, which will also include practical exercises to help you define a plan.

The day will end with an **opportunity for you to extend your network**. You will have the chance to connect with the other **artists**, **experts involved (met during the 3-day training programme) and our Alumni**, who have participated in the Summer Training programme over the years.

THE ARTIST AND THE OTHERS

The Artist and the Others is a nonprofit foundation which bases all activities on the understanding that the arts are important for our society, and the awareness of the benefits of shared knowledge. The foundation, initiated in 2013, supports artists and cultural professionals in building their careers in the cultural field, developing longlasting professional collaborations with institutions and artists. Their goal is to overcome the difficulties that artists and cultural professionals encounter in the first years after their studies, a critical period when they need to establish connections, and develop the knowledge and necessary skills to boost their future careers. The Artist and the Others first launched the Summer Training in 2019, proudly seeing the positive impact that this training has on participating artists.

PLATFORM

PLATFORM is a contemporary art space and qualification project for artists, curators and those involved in the culture sector in the city of Munich. Since 2009, it has been funded by the Münchner Beschäftigungs- und Qualifizierungsprogramm (MBQ) of the Department of Labour and Economic Affairs. The project is supported by Münchner Arbeit, a non-profit GmbH. It is unique in Germany for its combination of a demanding curatorial program, qualifications for the cultural labour market, and the provision of studio spaces for visual artists and creative people.

The Summer Training Programme is co-produced by The Artist and the Others, PLATFORM Munich, and Kompetenzteam Kultur-und Kreativwirtschaft.
